I know that a lot of you who have ordered my e books, that after you've learned the tarot or wanted to branch out your tarot business to the internet, you've been having problems finding sites to work. So, I've been researching and I've found three places that may be a possibility for your advancement.

Bitwine is a site that has been

around for a couple of years. I, personally, have joined this site and find the navigating of the chat suite to be one of the most easiest I've encountered. Also, after a reading, you are paid instantly through your Paypal account! Their support team is very quick to answer any questions you have, and the whole psychic community, though small, is friendly and quick to help.

On the downside, Bitwine isn't well-known, and sometimes you won't get a call for hours. But, I really don't see this as a long-lasting detriment, because Bitwine is becoming more popular as they continue to add new readers and grow. Lifestylerescue is another relatively new on line psychic chat site. Keep in mind, these sites also have other areas of expertise, so if it's not psychic readings you wish to pursue, then check out the other categories. I've been told that this site does not have a whole lot of traffic and that a new reader who isn't bringing existing clientele with them, might be sitting for a VERY long time

before receiving a call. This really is to be expected when a reader starts out at any new site, so your marketing skills will need to be worked. Their commission structure is also lower than some, so this might entice a reader to sign up.

Modes of communication: chat, phone, webcam, email

This site was brought to my attention by Kelly Said. Kelly did say this site is slow, also. The site is chat only, and if you go to it, you'll see that the home page offers quite a few free things to peruse such as: Daily Tarot, Free

Sample Tarot Reading, and a Daily affirmations. All of this is at your disposal after you have logged in. But, all in all, this site is the only one I saw that offered more information other than it's

readers and categories. So, the site could be fun to go to as a favorite, just to look up the affirmations. Also, you could use that tidbit as a marketing ploy to get clients to come to your page.

Now that you are thinking about doing readings, I'd like to go over some information you might find useful.

First there are three types of readings you will be asked about: Love, Money, and Career. The most frequent of these request will concern

love. If you specialize in relationship readings, then you are already ahead of the game and I'd strongly encourage you to market that point. As far as money questions go, I am finding more and more people are asking questions about when they will find a job and how will they survive

until that time? Those who are interested in career, are asking about how a job interview went and if they got the job. Also, they want to know about promotions. Be prepared to answer and tackle these concerns by using a certain spread, cards, or personal experiences. Your clients will love you!

What to Look for in Clients

When you begin you on line psychic business you will find that all the sites have one thing in common – all let your client rate you and their reading at the end of the session. This is indicated by either a star rating, or thumbs up or thumbs down, or some other method to gauge the client's pleasure or displeasure about their experience. You might shrink away from this practice, but

the reality of the on line business is that it's going to happen. So, that being said, I want to prepare you for some client types. Because even though the client can rate you and the reading, you also have control over whether or not you even want to read for that client in the first place. A number of bad ratings can hurt your business, and no matter what, it's virtually

impossible for you to appeal to the company to remove that rating. With that being said, it's time to protect yourself and your business. And the first way to do that is to know a little more about the wants, needs, and motives of the clientele.

Wants: most all who go to psychic lines want an answer to their question and are legitimately calling for the unknown to be made known.



The "Exceptions"

But, then there are the exceptions. When you first sign up, you are a new advisor. A clients likes your photo, profile, and experience, so they call. You chat for a moment and find out what they want. The client tells you, and before

any hiring is done, you feel that this person is legit and the reading will be beneficial for both you and her. Then there is the client who you can tell needs a little help getting back on track because after you ask them their question, they tell you but

then continue to ramble on and on. Your time is money. This client is developing a rapport with you, but they aren't paying for your time. The third type of client is the game-player. They really have nothing better to do than hire you for a minute, then call back and threaten to rate badly if you don't give a free reading.

PREDICTIONS
